

Interview With Dr. Oktay

Dr. Oktav is one of the first Turks to come to the Bay Area.

Amerika'ya ne zaman ve 0: geldiniz? nasıl Hikayenizi anlatabilir misiniz?

A: ABD'ye 1977 yılında geldim. Üniversitesinde Stanford Computer Engineering master yaptım.

Q: Adaptasyon sürecinde yaşadığınız bir problem oldu mu? Nasıl üstesinden geldiniz?

A: Benim ABD'ye geldiğim yıllarda maalesef buralarda çok az Türk vardı. Fakat üniversite civarında az sayıda da olsa Türkler vardı. Onlarla irtibatımı muhafaza etmeye çalıştım. Benim Stanforda geldiğim yıl üniversite kampüsünde Cuma namazları kılınmaya başladı. Daha sonraki yıllarda SF Bay Area da hem Türk toplumu ve hem de Müslümanların sayısında ciddi artışlar oldu. O yüzden adaptasyon problemi pek yaşamadım.

Q: Başka Kültürden insanlarla diyalog ve bağlantı kurarken dikkat etmemiz gereken veya önemli noktalar nelerdir?

A: Nasıl ki biz diğer kültürlerden gelen insanların bize saygı duymasını bekliyorsak bizler de onlara (onların kültürlerine) saygı duymamız gerekir.

Interview With Dr. Oktay (Continued)

Q: Sizce Amerika'da bir Türk olarak yaşamak nasıl bir deneyim/experience?

A: Kişinin kendi ülkesinin dışında başka bir ülkede yaşaması başta bazı zorluklar getirir fakat insan yavaş yavaş bulunduğu ülkeye alışır (adaptasyon). Şöyle bir Türk atasözü vardır "Insanın vatanı doğduğu yer değil, doyduğu yerdir." Bence Türkler ABD de dahil dünyanın pek çok ülkesinde bulunmalıdırlar. Kültürümüzün güzelliklerini ve yüksek ahlaki değerlerimizi gittiğimiz ülkede yaşatmalıyız.

Q: Gençlik yaşlarınıza geri dönebilseydiniz, dönermiydiniz?

A: O yaşlara geri dönmeyi pek düşünmedim. Şimdi iyiki dönmemişim burada kalmışım diyorum.




Tea Talk 03




Bay Area Sports Clubs
