

Building Bridges program

Christ Church, Beth Am, and Pacifica Institute congregation members joined for the six-session Interfaith Bridges Program project from November 2022 to February 2023. The participants met once every two weeks on Wednesdays from 6:30 pm - 9:30 pm at faith houses. Each session had a topic with a video presentation, discussion, and learning from each other's faith traditions

Participants had sanctuary tours, observed prayer practices, and interacted with clergy. Each session served food brought by participants as a potluck. It was a wonderful experience enjoying new dishes and sharing thoughts at the assigned round tables. The project aimed to bring people of three faith traditions together, build lasting friendships, and remove stereotypes. Facilitators from all three institutions had done a great job by well planning the sessions.

The Building Bridges program is designed and promoted by Building Bridges Together organization. Dr. Oktay Erbil a volunteer of Pacifica Institue is one of the founding members of the establishment. Cooking Classes at Home

Cooking Classes were one of the important events at Pacifica Institute's center in Sacramento where participants learned one Turkish dish at a time. The sessions were organized by Pacifica's women volunteers, announced publicly on Eventbrite, and were attended by guests from different walks of life. Unfortunately COVID-19 pandemic led to the closure of the Pacifica center which also resulted in the ending of Cooking Class events.

However, Ms. Eda Dogan, one of our community member was always been in search of different ways of organizing the cooking class. Spontaneously, she shared her thoughts about this in an iftar with her friends, and the idea of doing classes at home by inviting others and doing this as a workshop has come up. Now, the cooking class group gathers every month in one of the member's houses and the host demonstrates the meal of her culture, becoming into Interethnic Cooking Club.

The group has only 8 members due to limited kitchen space. Performing cooking classes as a small and closed group leads the ladies to have intense conversations and sincere relationships with each other. Sometimes, the group organizes family gettogethers to let all family members get to know each other. Currently, other ladies in the community are discussing creating their small groups by inviting their friends, neighbor, or coworkers who are interested in cultural exchange in cooking.



Our panel will showcase three innovative projects that aim to empower women and young girls through the use of technology.

The first project (HER) is an online tutoring program designed to help and empower Afghan refugee girls at middle school. Through this program, girls are connected with tutors who provide them with academic support and mentorship. The goal of this project is to help these girls overcome the challenges they face as refugees and gain the skills and confidence they need to succeed. The second project (Python4Girls & Hackathon4Girls) is focused on encouraging and motivating young women and girls to pursue careers in the tech field. Through a series of free coding classes and hackathons, we aim to inspire young women to explore their interests in tech and gain the skills they need to succeed. By creating a supportive and inclusive environment, we hope to break down barriers that have traditionally kept women out of the tech industry. Finally, our third project focuses on sparking climate change activism in young girls through the agency of innovation and technology. By providing girls with the tools and resources they need to learn about climate change and take action, we hope to create a generation of young women who are passionate about protecting our planet.

These three projects are just a few of the many ways in which technology can be harnessed to empower women and young girls. Through this panel, we hope to inspire and encourage others to use technology as a means of empowering women and girls and creating a more equitable world.


