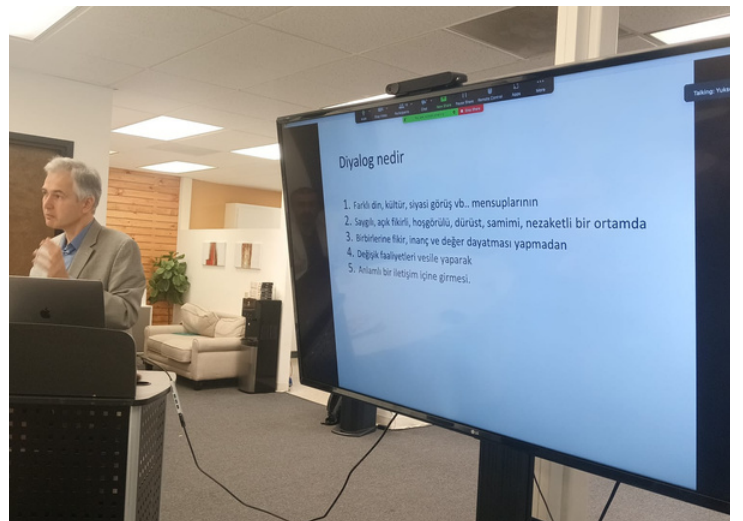
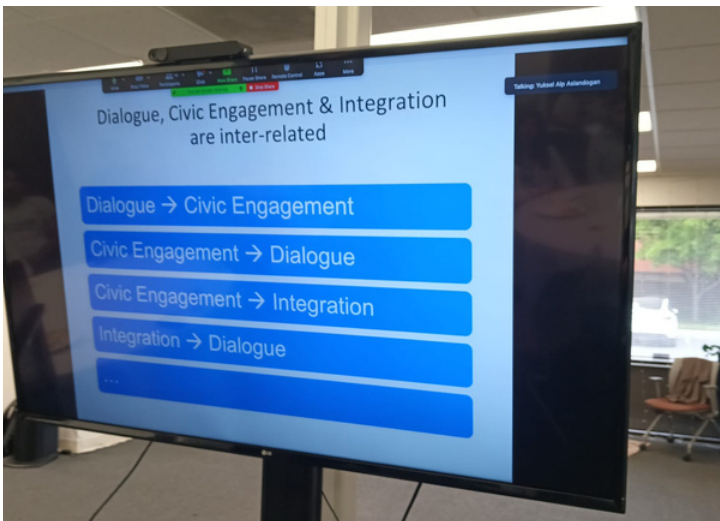

## Lecture by Alin Ozinian on “Polarization in Turkey”

Ethnically Armenian-Turkish writer Alin Ozinian was hosted by BAYCC at its center to deliver a talk on “Otherization in Turkey: From Past to Present” on 13th September. The author described how Armenian communities in Turkey were systemically polarized, seen as communities of suspicion, and became “others” in their own homeland. The writer mentioned that it is not only Armenians who are victims of otherization; Alevites, Kurdish, Hizmet movement members, and other ethnic and religious minorities face social stigmatization.

# Interfaith Prayer on International Peace Day

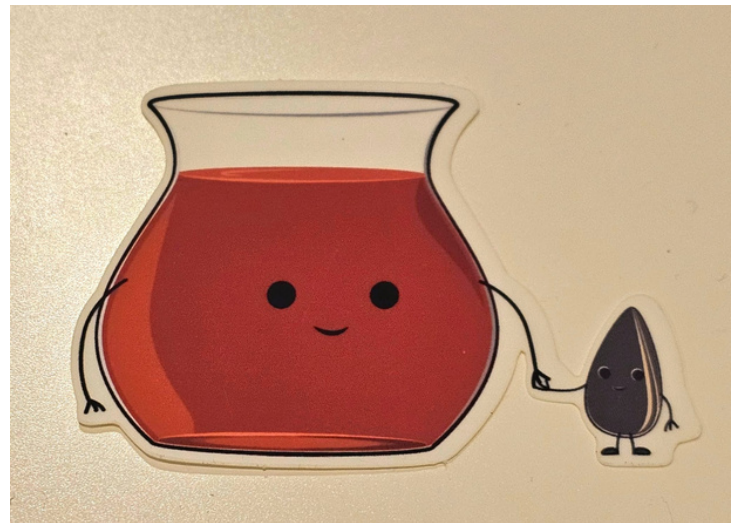

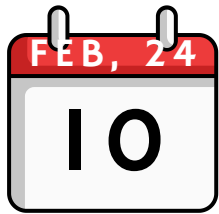
