




# MIDDLE-HIGH SCHOOL SUMMER CAMP

# ONLINE LECTURE ON "ISLAM'S JESUS"

On June 8, 2024, Bay Area Cultural Connections (BAYCC) hosted an online lecture titled "Islam's Jesus," featuring Professor Zeki Saritoprak, the Bediuzzaman Said Nursi Chair in Islamic Studies and professor in the Department of Theology and Religious Studies at John Carroll University, Cleveland, Ohio. Conducted through Zoom, the lecture attracted more than 40 participants and explored the theological teachings and place of Jesus in Islam, providing a comprehensive overview of the interfaith relations between Christianity and Islam. This lecture followed an earlier one by Professor Saritoprak on "Spirituality in Islam," marking his second engaging and educational session for our community and further enhancing participants' understanding of vital Islamic concepts and thoughts.





# PARTICIPATING IN UNITY WALKATHON BY AAI

The Abrahamic Alliance International (AAi) organized a Unity Walkathon on June 9th, 2024, a significant event to foster peaceful coexistence among Jews, Christians, and Muslims. Participants were congregation members of several faith houses in Silicon Valley who walked in solidarity to raise funds for AAi's mission of alleviating poverty and promoting interfaith harmony. # OFFERING PRAYERS AT MULTIFAITH PRAYERS FOR PEACE & JUSTICE

The Multifaith Voices for Peace & Justice: A Peaceful Presence Gathering, themed "Our Journey Through Life and Death," took place on June 11, 2024, at the First Palo Alto United Methodist Church in Palo Alto, CA. Hosted by Reverend Burke Owens, the event began with a welcome address and passages from the Bible. Speakers included Hilal Cansizoglu from Bay Area Cultural Connections, representing the Muslim tradition, who discussed a prayerful conversation with Allah on facing death in life, and Caroline Pietrangelo Owens from the Ridhwan School, who guided a practice for peaceful presence. The gathering aimed to foster peace through reflective conversations and guided practices, concluding with communal prayers led by Reverend Burke Owens.





# DISTRIBUTION OF MEAT TO HOMELESS SHELTERS

The BAYCC and Pacifica Institute volunteers distributed 680 pounds of ground beef as part of the Eid-Al Adha celebration, a significant event in the Islamic calendar known for emphasizing charity and community support. Eid-Al Adha, also known as the Festival of Sacrifice. Muslims around the world engage in the ritual sacrifice of animals, typically distributing the meat to family, friends, and those in need. This tradition underscores the importance of sharing and supporting the less fortunate. The recipients of this generous distribution included families, homeless shelters, and service agencies in the Bay Area, ensuring that the spirit of Eid-Al Adha reached and benefited various community members.







# BEACH CLEAN-UP ON OCEAN DAY

On June 22nd, 2024, YouthLink, a group for social services under Bay Area Cultural Connections, successfully mobilized volunteers from Pacifica Institute and BAYCC organizations for the World Ocean Day Beach Cleanup at Mussel Rock Beach, an event organized as part of the Pacific Beach Coalition. 
