

While we weren't able to provide freshly sacrificed meat due to logistical challenges, we did our best to uphold the meaning and essence of Eid by sourcing quality meat from trusted suppliers and restaurant depots. This effort was our humble way of making sure the spirit of Qurbani was felt and shared among our neighbors.



SHARING IN EID AL-ADHA

On the blessed day of Eid al-Adha, a meaningful act of service took place in Fremont, California. A group of volunteers came together to purchase and distribute fresh Kurban meat to Afghan refugee families who have recently arrived in the United States under difficult circumstances.

The meat was delivered directly to 25 families in need. These families, many of whom recently fled hardship and persecution in their home country, are struggling to establish a new life here. Language barriers, financial challenges, and the emotional toll of displacement make holidays especially difficult for them.

Eid al-Adha is more than a ritual — it's a celebration of faith, sacrifice, and unity. Acts like these remind us that despite different backgrounds and tongues, we are one Ummah, bound by shared belief and brotherhood. May this service be accepted by Allah and inspire more kindness and solidarity.

CONGRESSIONAL AWARDS 2025

From June 10–13, six outstanding students from our community traveled to Washington, D.C. to receive the prestigious Gold Congressional Award Medal, the highest honor Congress bestows upon youth. As part of the national ceremony, students had the opportunity to meet and network with Senators, Congress members, and fellow awardees from across the country, while also exploring the capital and celebrating their hard-earned achievements.

Out of 156 medals awarded nationwide, 35 were from California, and 6 of those students came from our BAYCC community—a remarkable accomplishment that reflects their dedication to personal development, service, and leadership. We are incredibly proud of their success and the inspiration they bring to our broader community.
