5TH WEST PLATFORM CIVIC CONVENTION

The 5th West Platform Civic Convention brought together over 200 Hizmet volunteers and community leaders from 13 Western states for a weekend of reflection, collaboration, and renewal. Hosted at Embassy Suites Milpitas and BAYCC under the theme "Legacy in Action: Building Hizmet's Future," the event explored how the spirit of vefa—faithful remembrance and gratitude—can guide the next generation of service, education, and dialogue.

From heartfelt keynotes and inspiring breakout sessions to the moving Spiritual Legacy Program and Hizmet Awards, the weekend combined learning with sincere connection. Cross-state teams exchanged ideas

on youth leadership, education, dialogue, and digital outreach, while thoughtful hospitality—from family-friendly spaces to shared meals—made the experience feel like a reunion with purpose.

Beyond the individual sessions, the summit directly advanced BAYCC's broader goals:

The convention closed with a collective sense of hope—proof that Hizmet's legacy continues to live on through action, compassion, and community.





COMPASSION WEEK - SERVICE DAY 2025

On Sunday, October 12, Pacifica Institute proudly hosted the annual Compassion Week Service Fest in Santa Clara, honoring the legacy of Fethullah Gülen and his lifelong dedication to service, education, and peace. This community-wide initiative brought together members of all ages from local faith communities and partner organizations, including BayCC, Youthlink, and Rebekah Children's Services, to serve unhoused

and underserved neighbors through hands-on projects.

Volunteers participated in a variety of service activities, including:

- Creating fleece blankets for local shelters
- Assembling hygiene kits for unhoused neighbors
- Packing backpacks for students in transitional services
- Sewing pillowcases and crafting bracelets for unhoused youth



Youthlink members also prepared school backpacks for local elementary students, helping children start the year with confidence. The day began with a remembrance of Gülen's vision of kindness and social responsibility, followed by an afternoon of collaboration, reflection, and community spirit. Volunteers and families left inspired, reminded that acts of service, big or small, strengthen the bonds within our community.





2ND "SEEKING GOD TOGETHER" GATHERING

On Saturday, October 18, 2025, Pacifica Institute, Maryknoll Fathers and Brothers, and the Peninsula Multifaith Coalition co-hosted the second Seeking God Together Interfaith Gathering at the Miwok Picnic Shelter in Huddart Park, Woodside, California. The event focused on the theme "Exploring God's Beautiful Attributes Across Faith Traditions", bringing together participants from multiple faith backgrounds for dialogue, reflection, and fellowship.

The day began with a shared charcoal-prepared BBQ lunch, creating a

warm and welcoming atmosphere for conversation and connection. Six distinguished faith and community leaders then offered presentations on the divine attributes in their traditions, highlighting universal values such as compassion, mercy, love, and justice.

Participants continued the discussion in reflection circles and group dialogues, exploring how these qualities can inspire personal growth and strengthen community bonds. The event concluded with an optional nature hike, providing a quiet moment for contemplation amidst the natural beauty of Huddart Park. As the second gathering in this series, the event reaffirmed the importance of interfaith dialogue in fostering understanding, peace, and connection across communities.
